  - A. Fall season athlete only (played soccer)? **The student would serve the 25% of the season penalty the next fall soccer season.**
  - B. In season athlete on swim team? **Providing there was still 25% of the season left when the violation occurred, they would serve it in season, if not it would carryover to the next season they participate in.**
  - C. Spring season athlete only? **No penalty**
5. Is it okay for a basketball coach to work with his/her seniors after the completion of the season? Yes or No **Yes**
